TO VOTE IN THE BROXTOWE BOROUGH AND PARISH ELECTIONS ON 2 MAY 2019 YOU WILL NEED ID

ID can be **ONE** form of photographic ID including:

- Passport
- Driving Licence
- Electoral Identity Card
- European Identity Card
- Ministry of Defence Identity Card
- Travel Pass
- Photocard Parking Permit

or **TWO** forms of non-photographic ID including:

- Poll card
- Debit or credit card
- Bank statement
- Mortgage statement (dated within 12 months of the election)
- Credit card statement (dated within 3 months of the election)
- Utility bill (dated within 3 months of the election)
- Council Tax bill
- P45 or P60 (dated within 12 months of the election)
- Birth certificate
- Marriage or civil partnership certificate
- Adoption certificate
- Paper driving licence
- Benefits statements
- Student loan statement (dated within 12 months of the election)
- National Insurance Number Card or a letter sent by HMRC issuing your National Insurance Number

If you do not have one of the specified forms of ID, you can apply for a Certificate of Identity.
